JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006).

<u>FACTS</u>

- 1. That Gary and James Szczeblewski ("Respondents") are the current owners and operators of a facility located at 402 East Yung Road, Sesser, Franklin County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Sesser/Szczeblewski, Gary J. and James R. Property.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0550455034.
 - That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on June 11, 2009, Maggie Stevenson of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of

her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>Jave 25</u>, 2009, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7007 3020 0002 3214 3404 4 7007 3020 0002 3214 3503.</u>

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Maggie Stevenson during the course of her June 11, 2009 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2006).
- That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2006).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2006), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>September 1, 2009</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2006), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2006). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

This follow-up was made as the result of a complaint received by this office and a May 31, 2009 deadline for cleanup. The site is located at ~402 E. Yung Road (approximation given by Franklin County Tax Assessor) in Sesser, Illinois. The site was easily accessed by a field road next to Burlington Northern Railroad. According to the Franklin County Tax Assessor, the property is owned by Gary J and James R. Szczeblewski of 411 E. Franklin Street in Sesser. The tax bill is being sent to Gary J. and James R. Szczeblewski at P.O. Box 564 in Sesser, Illinois. The parcel number is 01-12-402-001, lot 3 of SE Yung Road. Phil Fatka accompanied this inspector on the follow-up. Twelve pictures were taken of the waste, which consisted of metals, shingles, construction/demolition debris (CDD), furniture, burned debris, and general refuse. Open burning had occurred at the site and was noted during the previous inspection.

We arrived at the site to find the gate onto Yung Road still open (picture 001). A field road led through the gate and semi-parallel with the railroad tracks. The field road was extremely muddy and the truck we were driving had to put in 4-wheel drive in order to access the area of open dumping. We drove down the field road and spotted several areas of open dumping that were still visible even with the weeds now overgrown (pictures 002-005 and 007-012). Picture 006 shows the amount of weed growth since the March 31, 2009 initial inspection. It was apparent from the debris on site that the waste had been brought in from off-site and continued to be brought in as pictures 008 and 009 show new waste (a cigarette sorter from a store) having been added since the last inspection. We were able to go over the running waster (creek bed or field tile area) but the field had been planted just north of the water and we were unable to access any area having to do with the mine (AMLRP). The noted open dumping is approximately 1/8 to \(^1/4\) mile from any mine related structures or shafts.

Pictures 0550455034~03312009-012 through 013 show the gate open and CDD as you enter the gate. The same remains for this inspection as shown in picture 0550455034-06112009-001. The debris is obscured by the overgrowth between the field road and the railroad tracks. Picture 0550455034~06112009-002 shows the presence of CDD and a tire not noted during the previous inspection. Pictures 0550455034~06112009-003 and 004 show the same debris present in pictures 0550455034~03312009-003 and 004. The tires are now hidden due to the weed overgrowth in the area. Picture 0550455034~06112009-005 shows the same plastic (teal colored) slide, shingles, and a white garden hose hidden by overgrowth as in picture 0550455034~03312009-005. Pictures 0550455034~06112009-007 through 010 shows waste (55-gallon drums and commercial debris) not noted during the


previous inspection. Pictures 0550455034~06112009-011 is the same waste pile noted in picture 0550455034~03312009-010 with more CDD added since the previous inspection. Picture 0550455034~06112009-012 shows the same waste (including a couch) as noted in picture 0550455034~03312009-006 during the previous inspection. Some waste noted during the initial inspection was no longer visible due to the vegetation overgrowth now on the site.

It is still unknown at this time if waste is also being dumped on railroad right-of-way property.






