Dear Mr. Girard:

Earlier this year in January, 2009, I had filed a complaint with the Pollution Control Board, demanding a hearing to remove a July 2006 "Forged IEPA Seal Order 2006-3" and barricade placed across our 16-acre parcel, that I reside upon, prohibiting any uses or development.


There was no original IEPA complaint hearing or PCB for a "Seal Order" as required by law. The PCB, by law, must participate in seal order issues.

My hearing was denied, by a July 23, 2009 Board Order, that treats this matter as an "Appeal". There is no appeal of a forged order obtained without any hearings, complaint and PCB participation, as set out in my August 3, 2009 letter to Chairman Girard under the Freedom of Information Act, which was totally ignored. Due process is not discretionary but mandatory, as required by oath of office.

I send this letter to the PCB under a second demand of the Freedom of Information Act, to be answered within 5 days, as amended by the governor recently.
