ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On November 30, 2009, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Paradigm Properties, Inc. (Paradigm Properties) may appeal an November 3, 2009 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2008); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied certain reimbursement costs concerning Paradigm Properties' clean up of a leaking underground storage tank located at 1102 Madison Street in Charleston, Coles County.

The Board extends the appeal period until March 9, 2010, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Paradigm Properties fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
