JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008).

FACTS

- 1. That Tony A. Luttrell ("Respondent") is the present owner and operator of a facility located at approximately 800 North Aspen Road, Xenia, Clay County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") as Xenia/Luttrell, Tony A. and Crystal K. (northeast).
- That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection
 Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0258095001.
 - 3. That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on October 27, 2009, Garrison Gross of the Illinois EPA's Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 5. That on <u>Pecember 1, 2009</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7007 3020 0002 3214 4289.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his October 27, 2009 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2008).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of clean or general construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2008).

CIVIL PENALTY

On May 2, 2002, and September 5, 2002, the Board found Tony A. Luttrell in violation of Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(7) of the Act in AC 02-48 and AC 03-01.

Because this Administrative Citation addresses a second or subsequent violation of Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(7) of the Act, pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than December 31, 2009, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be

assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Three Thousand Dollar (3,000.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2008). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Subject: Open Dump Site Inspection at Tony A. & Crystal K. Luttrell (northeast) Property

General Remarks: An Open Dump Site Inspection was conducted on Tuesday, October 27, 2009, at the property of Tony A. & Crystal K. Luttrell. Garrison Gross of the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land conducted the inspection. The property is located at ~800 North Aspen Road, Xenia, Illinois 62899. The inspection was performed as a follow up to a complaint (C-10-046-M) alleging open dumping and burial of demolition waste. The inspection began at approximately 10:40 AM. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were overcast skies, drizzle, 55° F, and a light breeze.

Inspection Findings: The Inspector located the site and observed a lowboy trailer (plate # 8330 T/K) parked along Aspen Road. A tandem dump truck (plate # 16655 Q) was observed and it was backing down a gravel road on the property. A trackhoe was observed further south on the property. Upon entering the site, construction / demolition debris was observed along the east property boundary (photo 001). The inspector parked the vehicle due to the wet conditions and continued on foot. The inspector spoke to the driver of the tandem truck. He identified himself as Rex Brown. The Inspector identified himself and explained the reason for the inspection. Mr. Brown suggested that I speak with the owner in the trackhoe. The door of the tandem truck was labeled "Luttrell Backhoe".

The Inspector spoke to the operator of the Caterpillar 312 C trackhoe. He identified himself as Tony Luttrell. The Inspector identified himself and explained the reason for the inspection. Mr. Luttrell stated that he was demolishing a house and was under the impression that waste could be buried at the site. The Inspector informed him that Illinois EPA Regulations did not allow the burial of construction / demolition waste. He was informed that clean concrete, brick and soil could be used as fill material, but that pits should not be excavated for disposal purposes. He was informed that applications such as filling in an old basement or leveling a low area were acceptable uses and clean concrete could be crushed and reused as an aggregate. The Inspector explained that larger excavations; such as ponds, lakes, quarries and mines required a permit prior to filling with clean demolition debris. It was reiterated that digging pits and burying waste was a violation. Mr. Luttrell admitted that approximately one tandem load of brick had been buried further south at the site. The Inspector requested that Mr. Luttrell cease open dumping of construction / demolition waste and haul the waste to a permitted landfill for disposal. Mr. Luttrell estimated that seven (7) roll off boxes of waste were present at this location and the demolition site. The Inspector informed him that he would be receiving a letter from the Agency in a few days and that landfill receipts would be required to document compliance.

The Inspector continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site. A large pile of demolition waste was observed. The pile measured approximately 55 x 12 x 5 feet (photos 002-

004). Wastes including but not limited to dimensional lumber, plywood, tar paper, shingles, linoleum and carpeting were observed. Evidence of waste burial was observed (photo 005). Concrete blocks, shingles, dimensional lumber, and plywood were observed in a shallow excavated pit. Smaller piles of demolition waste were observed nearby and contained dimensional lumber, plywood, concrete blocks and pipe (photos 006-008). Evidence of additional waste burial was observed further south along the property boundary (photo 009). Recently excavated soil was higher than the surrounding area. Approximately 150 cubic yards of demolition waste were observed but it is estimated that approximately 200 cubic yards of demolition waste is located at the site, including waste that is buried. The inspection ended at approximately 11:00 AM

Additional Remarks: Information concerning property ownership / control was obtained through tax records from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Clay County. Tony A. & Crystal K. Luttrell were identified as the owners of the property and tax bills are mailed to 642 Honey Locust Lane, Xenia, Illinois, 62899. The property is referred to as parcel 09-34-400-003 and contains approximately 14.89 acres. The waste was being transported from property owned by Wanda Brinkley, 7748 Old Highway 50, Flora, Illinois 62839. That property is referred to as parcels 10-27-403-005 and 10-27-400-038.


