Re: Grant of Provisional Variance from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 215.301

Dear Mr. Pinto:

On October 28, 2009, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") received from Equistar Chemicals, LP ("Equistar"), a request for a provisional variance from the requirement under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 215.301 for emissions from an uncontrolled process vent in an alcohol unit during a plant trial of a new product. The request was accepted for review pursuant to the requirements of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act") and applicable regulations.

The Illinois EPA has evaluated the request in accordance with the requirements of Sections 35, 36, and 37 of the Act and the Illinois EPA's regulations set forth at 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 180. The Illinois EPA is granting Equistar's request for provisional variance, subject to the conditions delineated below, due to the short-term nature of the relief and because the request and supporting documentation have demonstrated that an arbitrary and unreasonable hardship would result in the event of a denial.

The Illinois EPA is granting Equistar relief from the aforementioned regulatory requirement under Section 215.301 for a 45-day period, as requested by Equistar. Specifically, this relief is granted from May 10, 2010, until June 24, 2010, at which time this grant and its terms expire. This action affording relief is based, in principal part, upon Equistar's representation that no significant adverse environmental effect is expected as a result of the requested relief. The requested relief shall extend to Equistar's uncontrolled process vent in the alcohol unit during a trial of the manufacture of isopropanol ("IPA"), subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Equistar shall notify the Illinois EPA in writing at least 3 days before the initial start of the IPA trial and within 7 days after the conclusion of the IPA trial.
- 2. Equistar shall maintain and submit to the Illinois EPA records containing all data collected throughout the term of this provisional variance for the IPA trial regarding propylene feed (lb) and IPA manufactured (lb).

- 3. Equistar shall maintain and submit to the Illinois EPA records of actual organic material emissions, on an hourly basis, throughout the term of this provisional variance from the IPA trial with supporting data and calculations.
- 4. Equistar shall maintain an operation log throughout the term of this provisional variance for the IPA trial, including the dates of plant changeover to and from the trial, startup date of the IPA trial, and duration of the IPA trial.
- 5. Reports and information required under paragraphs 2 and 3 above shall be submitted within 30 days after the term of the provisional variance to:

The Illinois EPA requests that Equistar, following receipt of this provisional variance, submit a certification to the Illinois EPA signifying its acceptance of the terms and conditions expressed herein. The certification should be mailed to the Illinois EPA within 10 days of the date of this provisional variance and should be signed by the owner or operator, as follows:
