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RESPONSE TO MOTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL GROUPS TO SEVER, OPEN SUBDOCKET, AND PROCEED TO DECISION CONCERNING RECREATIONAL USE ISSUES

CITGO PETROLEUM CORPORATION, and PDV MIDWEST, LLC, operate and own, respectively, a refinery in Lemont Illinois. (The "Lemont Refinery") On January 7, 2010, the Lemont Refinery filed a motion asking the Board to hold hearings on the impact of ongoing litigation regarding Asian carp and their potential passage through the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal. On January 29, 2010, the Lemont Refinery filed a reply regarding the same matter. On February 3, 2010, certain environmental groups filed a motion asking the Board to sever the current proceeding and to open a subdocket for the proposed Chicago Area Waterway System recreational use designations, separate from the aquatic life issues impacted by the Asian carp. In accordance with the aforementioned, the Lemont Refinery submits the following Response to the aforementioned motion of the environmental groups.

- 1. The Lemont Refinery agrees with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's designation of the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal from its confluence with the Calumet-Sag Channel to its confluence with the Des Plaines River as non-recreational.
- 2. The Lemont Refinery stands by its previous motion and reply as regards all other matters currently before this board.

WHEREFORE, the Lemont Refinery respectfully requests that, if the Board grants the aforementioned motion of the environmental groups, then the Board also defer all other rulemaking that concerns the waters of the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal which all parties have agreed should be deemed "non-recreational."
