REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, James G. Richardson, Assistant Counsel, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to June 7, 2010, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of receipt of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On January 29, 2010, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner.
- 2. On March 4, 2010, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA to join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition by ninety days. Upon information and belief the Petitioner did receive the final decision on February 2, 2010.

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.

Dear Mrs. Thomas:

This will acknowledge receipt of your Application for Permit to modify a solid waste management site, dated and received by the Illinois EPA on December 4, 2007.

Your permit application to revise the post-closure care cost estimates is denied.

You have failed to provide proof that granting this permit would not result in violations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act). Section 39(a) of the Act [415 ILCS 5/39(a)] requires the Illinois EPA to provide the applicant with specific reasons for the denial of permit. The following reason(s) are given:

Pursuant to 35 III. Adm. Code Section 807.622(d), post-closure care cost estimates must include all groundwater monitoring parameters at the frequency indicated in the permit. This application failed to meet this regulation. The cost estimate of \$35,606.00 proposed in the application assumes that only detection groundwater monitoring will need to be done during the remainder of the post-closure care period. However, there are groundwater exceedences in the vicinity of this landfill and a groundwater assessment must be done as described in Supplemental Permit No. 2007-300-SP. Therefore, estimates should be calculated incorporating the assessment monitoring required by Supplemental Permit No. 2007-300-SP.

Within 35 days after the date of mailing of the Illinois EPA's final decision, the applicant may petition for a hearing before the Illinois Pollution Control Board to contest the decision of the

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Illinois EPA, however, the 35-day period for petitioning for a hearing may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice provided to the Board from the applicant and the Illinois EPA within the 35-day initial appeal period.
