This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq. (2008), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

#### **FACTS**

- 1. The Respondent, Ed Cripps, is the present owner and occupant and in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.
- 2. The facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 0770505071. The facility is known to the Agency as the Murphysboro/Ed Cripps site.
- 4. The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 5. On January 26, 2010, Don Terry, Field Inspector, Jackson County Health Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Mr. Terry's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

#### **VIOLATIONS**

On the basis of Field Inspector, Don Terry's, direct observation, he has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on January 26, 2010, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

- 1. The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
- 2. The Respondent has caused or allowed the deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

#### **CIVIL PENALTY**

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than May 1, 2010, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondent fails to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) County of Jackson, c/o Jackson County Treasurer, Jackson County Courthouse, Murphsyboro, Illinois 62966; and
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal

Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may either initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

#### PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall also be filed with Daniel Brenner, Assistant State's Attorney, Jackson County Courthouse, Third Floor, Murphysboro, II 62966. YOUR PETITION FOR REVIEW MUST BE FILED WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THE DATE OF SERVICE OF THE PRESENT CITATION ON YOU. YOUR PETITION MUST STATE THE REASON(S) YOU BELIEVE THE PRESENT MATTER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED. IF YOU FAIL TO FILE YOUR PETITION AND STATE THE REASONS THE PRESENT MATER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED, A DEFAULT ORDER AGAINST YOU WILL BE ENTERED BY THE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.

#### **GENERAL REMARKS**

During the stated date and time, I conducted an inspection of the site listed above. This inspection was made as a follow up to an inspection conducted on January 2, 2008 during which open dumping violations were observed. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were: cloudy with strong, gusting winds and a temperature of approximately 37°F. I was accompanied on this inspection by Henry Mulder of the Jackson County Health Department.

According to records at the Jackson County Assessor's Office, the site is owned by Ed Cripps residing at 429 S. 17<sup>th</sup> St., Murphysboro, IL 62966.

I arrived at 429 S. 17<sup>th</sup> Street, and from 17<sup>th</sup> Street, a public roadway, observed open dumped waste (Photos #1 - #3, Site Sketch-Area A). The waste in this area consisted of, but was not limited to: abandoned vehicles, waste tires, scrap metal, plastic items, vehicle parts and furniture (Photos #1 - #3, Site Sketch-Area A). At the time of the inspection, the vehicles and other items observed from this location were not in use, were not useable in their current condition, were not stored in such a way as to protect any future use and were stored in an unsightly manner.

I then drove to a location at the northwest corner of the residence and observed more open dumped waste (Photos #4 - #6, Site Sketch-Area A). The waste I observed from this location consisted of, but was not limited to: abandoned vehicles, vehicle parts, scrap metal, a plastic barrel, paper, waste tires, lawn mowers, and furniture. At the time of the inspection, the vehicles and other items observed from this location were not in use, were not useable in their current condition, were not stored in such a way as to protect any future use and were stored in an unsightly manner.

I proceeded to the north end of the site and walked south (Photos #7 - #17, Site Sketch-Area B). The open dumped waste I observed, scattered around the site, consisted of, but was not limited to: abandoned vehicles, waste tires, vehicle parts, plastic items, dimensional lumber and scrap metal (Photos #7 - #17, Site Sketch-Area B). At the time of the inspection, the vehicles and other items observed in this area were not in use, were not useable in their current condition, were not stored in such a way as to protect any future use and were stored in an unsightly manner.

The total volume of waste observed during this inspection was approximately 120 cubic yards.

My inspection ended at approximately 11:17 a.m.


