## **HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On March 22, 2010, the following parties participated in a telephone status conference with the hearing officer: Complainant; A.E. Staley Manufacturing Co.; Aramark Uniform Services, Inc.; Bell Sports, Inc.; Borden Chemical Co.; Bridgestone/Firestone, Inc.; Climate Control, Inc.; Caterpillar, Inc.; Combe Laboratories, Inc.; Trinity Rail Group, Inc..; and Triple S Refining Corporation. The following respondents did not appear: Waste Hauling Landfill, Inc.; Jerry Camfield; Archer Daniels Midland, Inc.; General Electric Railcar Services Corporation; P & H Manufacturing, Inc.; and Zexel Illinois. Complainant has made contact with Zexel Illinois, Inc. but is considering whether to involve one or more of Zexel's predecessor companies.

Complainant plans to file a motion to voluntarily dismiss the action against Archer Daniels Midland. Additionally, complainant is reviewing settlement offers from General Electric Railcar Services and P & H Manufacturing. The remaining parties continue to discuss settlement, and the deadline for answers to the complaint remain stayed for all respondents.

Pursuant to an agreement between the parties, the stay of proceedings against Triple S Refining Corporation is extended to July 20, 2010.

On January 22, 2010, complainant filed an amended complaint to correct several non-substantive issues. At complainant's request, the hearing officer will postpone action on the amended complaint pending settlement discussions.
