RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE ANSWER AND RECORD OF DETERMINATION

NOW COMES, Respondent, the ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

AGENCY, by and through its attorney, Lisa Madigan, Attorney General of the State of Illinois

("Attorney General") and Assistant Attorney General Evan J. McGinley, who respectfully move
the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d), for
leave to file an answer to Petitioner's, American Louver Company, Petition for Review of
Construction Permit for American Louver Company ("Petition for Review"), as well as the
record of determination for this matter. Respondent states the following in support of this
motion.

- 1. On March 19, 2010, Illinois EPA issued Construction Permit (Application No. 09110020) which Illinois EPA issued to Petitioner ("Construction Permit"). The Construction Permit authorized Petitioner to construct a new plastic blow molder at its facility, which is located at 7700 Austin Avenue, Skokie, Illinois.
- 2. On April 26, 2010, Petitioner filed its Petition for Review with the Board, pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/40 (2008), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 105, Subpart. Petitioner, through its Petition, seeks review by the Board

of the Permit, arguing the new blow molding unit for which Petition submitted its Construction Permit is, in fact, exempt from permitting requirements. Petitioner's Petition further requests that the Board "stay of Standard Condition Number 6 of the [Construction P]ermit during the pendency of this appeal." Finally, Petitioner requests that the Board direct Respondent to return the Construction Permit fee of \$4,000.00.

- 3. By order of the Board, dated May 6, 2010, the Illinois EPA was directed to file its Answer to the Petition and the "record of its determination" within thirty (30) days from the date that the Petitioner filed its Petition. The thirty day period set by the Board's May 6th order expired on May 26, 2010.
- 4. On May 18, 2010, the Board set this matter for an initial telephonic status conference on June 3, 2010, at 9:45 a.m.
- 5. On May 26, 2010, Illinois EPA formally requested that the Attorney General represent the Agency relative to Petitioner's appeal.
- 6. Because Illinois EPA did not formally request representation by the Attorney General until the date that both its Answer and the filing of its Record of Determination were due, Illinois EPA, hereby requests that it be allowed to file its Answer and the Record of Determination related to the issuance of the Construction Permit on such dates as may be set by the Hearing Officer at the June 3, 2006 status conference.
- 7. The Petitioner will not be prejudiced by granting the Illinois Environmental
 Protection Agency such additional time to file its Answer and the Record of Determination as the
 Hearing Officer may determine to be appropriate.
