HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On June 29, 2010, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties discussed a discovery schedule and Waste Management of Illinois, Inc., (WMII), subsequently submitted a discovery schedule that was agreed to by all parties. The discovery schedule is accepted to the extent as follows: written discovery to be served on or before July 9, 2010; responses to written discovery to be served on or before August 7, 2010; completion of discovery on or before September 27, 2010; prehearing motions, including motions *in limine*, to be filed on or before September 29, 2010; responses to prehearing motions to be filed on or before October 1, 2010. The mailbox rule will not apply to the responses to any prehearing motions, and all electronic or approved telefax filings must be received by the Clerk's Officer no later than 4:30 p.m. of the due date.


It is anticipated that the hearing will be held on October 18 through the 20, 2010.

The discovery schedule and the dates of the hearing may be revisited at the next telephonic status conference.

WMII stated that it will file a waiver of the statutory decision deadline to and including December 16, 2010.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on July 22, 2010, at 2:00 p.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the petitioners, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matters and their readiness for hearing.


