**NOTICE OF WAIVER OF 120-DAY
DECISION DEADLINE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 30 DAYS**

NOW COMES Petitioner, KCBX TERMINALS COMPANY (“KCBX”), a North Dakota corporation, by and through its attorneys, HODGE DWYER & DRIVER, pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code § 101.308(c)(2), and hereby agrees to waive the statutory 120-day decision deadline for final action by the Illinois Pollution Control Board (“Board”) in this proceeding for an additional thirty (30) days, or until November 26, 2010. In support of this Notice, KCBX states as follows:

1. On June 29, 2010, KCBX filed a Petition for Review (“Petition”) of the “Construction Permit – Revised” issued to KCBX by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency on May 25, 2010. KCBX also filed a Motion to Stay the Effectiveness of Contested Permit Conditions (“Motion to Stay”) simultaneously therewith.

2. On July 15, 2010, the Board accepted the Petition for hearing, but reserved ruling on the Motion to Stay. Board Order, KCBX Terminals Company v. Illinois EPA, PCB No. 10-110 (Ill.Pol.Control.Bd. July 15, 2010).

3. The current statutory decision deadline for this matter is October 27, 2010.

4. KCBX hereby voluntarily agrees to waive the statutory 120-day decision deadline for an additional thirty (30) days, or until November 26, 2010, in order to conduct settlement negotiations in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, KCBX TERMINALS COMPANY, prays that the Illinois Pollution Control Board accept this waiver of the statutory 120-day decision deadline for an additional thirty (30) days for final action on KCBX's appeal of the "Construction Permit – Revised" issued to it by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.
