ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On January 30, 2009, the Office of the Attorney General, on behalf of the People of the State of Illinois (Complainant), filed a two-count complaint against Bill Woods, d/b/a American Asphalt Seal Coating (Bill Woods). The complaint concerns Mr. Woods' asphalt sealing operation, located in Troy, Madison County, and an action that took place at the parking lot of Cope Marine, a business located at 1725 W. Highway 50, O'Fallon, St. Clair County. On July 30, 2010, the complainant filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this enforcement action. The Board grants the complainant's motion, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
