REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECORD

NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of the State of Illinois and, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116, moves the Hearing Officer for an extension of the time to file the record of its determination in this matter.

- 1. Petitioner, Van Zelst Landscape Composting Facility, filed its Amended Petition with the Board on October 4, 2010, with service directed to Illinois EPA in Springfield, Illinois.
