ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.L. Blankenship):

On November 16, 2010, Mother Hubbard's Cupboard (MHC) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this underground storage tank (UST) appeal (Mot.), which concerns MHC's leaking UST site in Moline, Rock Island County. MHC's July 30, 2010 petition (Pet.) had sought Board review of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's June 28, 2010 determination "purporting to deny the [Stage 3 Site Investigation] plan and reimbursement for approved [Stage 1] work, as well as retroactively removing the incident from the Leaking Underground Storage Tank program." Pet. at 2. According to MHC's motion for voluntary dismissal, "the matters at issue have been settled" and the Agency "has no objection to the granting of this Motion." Mot. at 1. The Board grants the motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.
