## **HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

As scheduled by a December 10, 2010 order, the hearing in this docket took place on February 3, 2011, in Chicago. The hearing officer intends to begin the hearing with Mr. Sibbitt's pre-filed testimony and any questions based upon it. Participants who have not pre-filed testimony will be allowed to testify after the conclusion of Mr. Sibbitt's pre-filed testimony and questions based upon it.

Any participant who wishes to offer a public comment at the hearing will be allowed to do so as time allows at the close of testimony and questions based upon it. In addition, the Board's procedural rules include an opportunity to file post-hearing comments. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.108(b).
