- 1 HEARING OFFICER ROBERTSON: Good afternoon,
- 2 all. My name is Daniel Robertson, and I have been
- appointed by the Board to serve as Hearing Officer in
- 4 this proceeding entitled "In the Matter of Regulatory
- 5 Proposal for NOX Trading Program Sunset Provisions for
- 6 Non-Electric Generation Units: Amendments to 35
- 7 Illinois Administrative Code Part 217. Subpart U. " This
- 8 matter is listed as R11-8 in the Board's docket.
- 9 With me today is the presiding Board
- 10 Member, Gary Blankenship and next to him is Board
- 11 Member Andrea Moore and Board Member Carrie Zalewski.
- 12 To my left, we have Anand Rao of our technical unit and
- next to him is Acting Chairman, Dr. G. Tanner Girard
- and Board Member Tom Johnson. We also have one of our
- interns, Nick Garlisch.
- 16 This hearing was initially scheduled for
- 17 February 3rd, however, because of the severe winter
- weather in Chicago that week, a number of businesses
- 19 were closed down including the Pollution Control Board
- on Wednesday, February 2nd. We convened the hearing on
- the 3rd as scheduled and immediately continued it until
- 22 today. No testimony was given on that initial date and
- 23 no members of the public were present. I'll note that
- 24 any questions asked by a Board Member or staff is

- intended to help for a complete record of the Board's
- decision and not to experience any frequency of notion
- or bias. One of the purposes of this hearing is to
- 4 satisfy the Board's requirement under Section 27B of
- 5 the Environmental Protection Act. Section 27B of the
- 6 Act requires the Board to request the Department of
- 7 Commerce and Economic Opportunity to conduct an
- 8 Economic Impact Study on certain proposed Bureaus
- 9 before adoption of the rules.
- 10 If the DCEO chooses to conduct the
- 11 Economic Impact Study, the DCEO has 30 to 45 days after
- the Board's request to produce a study of the economic
- impact. The Board must then make the Economic Impact
- 14 Study or the DCEO's explanation for not conducting the
- study available to the public at least 20 days before a
- 16 public hearing on the economic impact of the proposed
- 17 rule.
- 18 In accordance with Section 27(b) of the
- 19 Act, the Board has requested in a letter dated
- 20 October 26, 2010 that the DCEO conduct an Economic
- 21 Impact Study for this rulemaking. The DCEO responded
- on December 7th stating that it is unable to undertake
- 23 the study. Both of these letters have been made
- 24 available to the public on the Board's Website. We

- also have copies of both letters in the back and we'll
- 2 take any questions on these later. I note that the
- 3 agency and its witness by the time and ask if they
- 4 could please give their names for record.
- 5 MS. DOCTORS: Rachel Doctors, Assistant
- 6 Counsel, Illinois, EPA.
- 7 MR. MAHAJAN: Yoginder Mahajan, Illinois
- 8 Environmental Protection Engineer, Illinois, EPA.
- 9 HEARING OFFICER ROBERTSON: Thank you. I
- note that we do not have any members of the public
- 11 present at this time. And as of today, we have not
- 12 received any pre-filed testimony for this hearing. Is
- there anybody here who would like to testify on any
- 14 matter in this rulemaking? Seeing no testimony, does
- anybody have any questions on the Board's letter to the
- 16 DCEO or the DCEO's response? See no questions.
- 17 At this time, I would like to go off the
- 18 record and set future dates for this rulemaking.
- 19 (WHEREUPON, a discussion was had
- off the record.)
- 21 HEARING OFFICER ROBERTSON: We'll go back on
- the record then. Off the record, we discussed dates
- for final comments. And the date for filing a final
- comment will be Monday, March 21, 2011. So if anyone
