ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

This order grants the April 19, 2011 motion for additional time to comply with the Board's order of March 3, 2011. Any responsive filing must be made on or before May 23, 2011.

On November 25, 2008, the Office of the Attorney General, on behalf of the People of the State of Illinois (People), filed a four-count complaint against Alan Durkee, doing business as Alan Durkee Swine Farm (respondent). The complaint concerns respondent's swine operation located at the intersection of County Road 800N and County Road 1700E, approximately two miles east of Stronghurst in Henderson County. On January 10, 2011, the parties filed a stipulation, proposal for settlement, and request for hearing relief. By order of March 3, 2011, the Board directs that an appropriate filing be made by April 4, 2011, to reconcile an inconsistency between the complaint and the stipulation.

On April 19, 2011, the complainant filed a motion for additional time to comply with the March 3 order. The People relate various steps taken to timely comply with the order, and state that it has experienced delay in receiving revised, executed documents from respondent. The People request "a few days" in which to make their responsive filing.

For good cause shown, the Board extends the date for filing documents responsive to its March 3, 2011 order until May 23, 2011.
