ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On June 27, 2011, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Mac's Convenience Stores, LLC (MCS), may appeal a May 25, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency approved payment for \$33,333.00 of the requested \$39,682.14 from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund in response to a leaking UST incident at MTR's property located 415 West Spressor Ave., Taylorville, Christian County.

The Board extends the appeal period until September 29, 2011, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If MCS fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
