ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On July 14, 2011, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the Center Point Energy – Mississippi River Transmission, LLC, (CPE) may appeal June 14, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency granted CPE a permit to operate a natural gas compressor station located at Summerfield Road, St. Jacob, Madison County.

The Board extends the appeal period until October 17, 2011, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If CPE fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
