NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION PURSUANT TO 415 ILCS 5/7.2(b)

Section 22.4(a) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) [415 ILCS 5/22.4(a)] requires the Board to adopt regulations that are "identical in substance" to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) hazardous waste rules adopted to implement Subtitle C of the federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA Subtitle C) (42 U.S.C. §§ 6921 et seq. (2008)). These rules are contained in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 701 through 705, 720 through 728, 733, and 739.

Section 7.2(a) of the Act [415 ILCS 5/7.2(a)] requires the Board to complete its identical-insubstance rulemaking actions within one year after the date of the USEPA action on which they are based. Section 7.2(b) [415 ILCS 5/7.2(b)] allows the Board to extend the deadline for adoption by publication of a notice of reason for delay in the *Illinois Register*.

By an order dated June 2, 2011, the Board set forth reasons for delay and extended the deadline for final action on the amendments from July 1, 2011 to October 17, 2011. That order stated in significant part as follows:

That order stated in significant part as follows:

EXTENSION OF DUE DATE AND TIMETABLE FOR COMPLETION

Under Section 7.2 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/7.2(b) (2008)), the Board must complete this rulemaking within one year of the date of the earliest set of federal amendments considered in this docket. USEPA adopted the earliest federal amendments that required Board attention on October 30, 2008, so that the nominal statutory deadline for Board adoption of these amendments was January 8, 2011.

By an order dated December 16, 2010, the Board found that delay was necessary and unavoidable in this matter. That order extended the deadline for completion from January 8, 2011 until July 1, 2011. A Notice of Public Information Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/7.2(b) appeared in the Illinois Register on January 3, 2001, at 35 Ill. Reg. 322.

Fulfilling the schedule projected in the December 16, 2010 order anticipated that the Board would adhere to the following schedule of intermediate actions:

Since that has not occurred, the Board finds that further delay is required. Principally, incorporating the January 8, 2010 amendments pertaining to import and export of hazardous waste, ensuring completion of the March 18, 2010 corrections, and a series of corrections and clarifications added by the Board have taken more effort than originally anticipated. Based on proposal of this opinion and the accompanying order on this date, the Board again finds that delay for completion of these amendments is necessary, from July 1, 2011 until October 17, 2011, according to the following schedule:

The Board also directs staff to cause publication of a Notice of Public Information on Proposed Rules in the *Illinois Register*, based on this order, which sets forth reasons for delay and extends the due date for this proceeding.
