## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G. T. Girard):

On July 7, 2011, at the parties' request, the Board extended until September 29, 2011, the time period for Mac's Convenience Stores, LLC (MCS) to appeal a May 25, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns MCS's underground storage tank (UST) site 415 West Spressor Ave., Taylorville, Christian County. The Agency approved payment for \$33,333.00 of the requested \$39,682.14 from the UST Fund in response to a leaking UST incident at MCS's property. Because MCS failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
