

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

1. That Rodney K. Burns is the current owner and operator ("Respondent") of a facility located in the East ¼ of the NW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Sec 34, T 16N, R 13W of the 3rd PM, Morgan County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Meredosia/Brown.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1378615002.
3. That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
4. That on September 14, 2011, William Zierath of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Springfield Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy

of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 11-8-11, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7004 2510 0001 8538 4496.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by William Zierath during the course of his September 14, 2011 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than November 30, 2011, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental

Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Affiant, William E. Zierath, being first duly sworn, voluntarily deposes and states as follows:

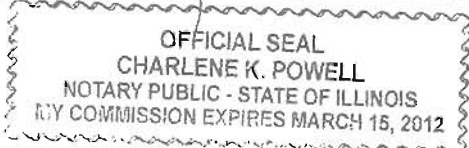

A complaint re-investigation was conducted at this property south of Meredosia, Illinois on September 14, 2011. No one was interviewed. The weather was cloudy, occasionally rainy and 70°F.

The initial complaint investigation was conducted on July 19, 2011. The complaint alleged that Rodney Brown, a roofing contractor, was hauling demolition waste from jobs he was working to this site and dumping and burning it. The complainant said that Mr. Brown was currently working at the "Cody and Son Funeral Home" in Meredosia. The complaint also alleged that the Morgan County Sheriff and the local fire department had responded to a recent fire at the site. The dumping and burning reportedly had been occurring for about a month.

During the July 19, 2011 investigation it was observed that there were several piles of wastes including wood demolition waste, other demolition waste, scrap metal, other junk and the ashes and burned tire bands from burned wastes around the site. There were four mobile homes observed on site. One of the mobile homes was occupied by Nick Brown (nephew of property owner Rodney Brown) and his family. The other three mobile homes were unoccupied and in various states of disrepair. There was also a pole building sided with corrugated metal on the northwest part of the site.

According to Nick Brown during the July 19, 2011 investigation, the recent fire at the site destroyed yet another mobile home.

Following the July 19, 2011 investigation an Administrative Citation Warning Notice dated July 27, 2011 was sent to Rodney Brown. The ACWN gave Mr. Brown until September 1, 2011 to clean up the site. Mr. Brown did not request an extension of the deadline. The purpose of the re-investigation was to determine if the waste had been removed from the site.

When entering this site I observed that the pole building at this site had been demolished. There were no further stationary structures at the site. The four mobile homes (one occupied and three unoccupied) were still present. The unoccupied mobile homes are ~~shown in photographs 014, 015, 016, 017, 018 and 019.~~

There was a pile of waste in the southwest part of the site. This pile is shown in photographs 001, 002 and 003. Most of the identifiable waste in this pile was wood demolition waste. This pile measured approximately 4 yards by 6 yards by up to 1 yd high. There was a considerable amount of ash in this pile. Since there were numerous individual pieces of wood waste in the pile that had previously been observed during the July 19, 2011 investigation and since none of the pieces of wood appeared to be burned or partially burned, it did not appear that the wastes in this pile had been burned since the ACWN had been received by Mr. Brown. There was no smoky smell in the area of this pile.

Southeast of the waste pile described above were two broken fiberglass boat hulls that had been dumped on the ground. These boat hulls are shown in photograph 004.

There was a pile of waste in the southeast part of the site. This pile is shown in photographs 005, 006, 007 and 008. The waste in this pile included wood demolition waste, scrap metal, the steel bands left from the burning of tires and assorted junk. This pile measured approximately 4 yards by 9 yards by up to a yard high. There was some ash around this pile. There was no smoky odor or smoke detectable near this pile.

In the middle of the site was another pile of waste. This pile is shown in photograph 009. The wastes in this pile included used siding, scrap metal and numerous broken telephones. This pile measured approximately 3 yards by 3 yards by up to 1 yard high. There was a small amount of ash around this pile, but there was no indication of recent burning.

There was another waste pile northeast of the pile shown in photograph 009. This pile is shown in photograph 010. This pile contained scrap metal, an old television, numerous broken telephones, pieces of plastic and other junk. There were ashes south of this pile, but there was no indication of recent burning. This pile measured approximately 4 yards by 5 yards by up to 1 yard high.

There was a pile of waste east of the former location of the building at this site. This pile is shown in photograph 011. The wastes observed in this pile included wood demolition waste, metal, plastic and assorted junk. This pile measured approximately 5 yards by 5 yards by over 1.5 yards high.

There was a small pile of waste located where the building used to be. This pile is shown in photograph 012. This pile measured approximately 3 yards by 4 yards by up to 1 yard high. Wastes in this pile included wood demolition waste, metal, and fiberglass siding.

South of the former location of the building at this site was another pile of waste. This pile of waste is shown in photograph 013. Wastes in this pile included wood demolition waste, metal, paper and assorted junk. This pile measured approximately 3 yards by 5 yards by up to 1 yard high.

There was scattered waste on the ground east of the unoccupied mobile homes. Wastes included old furniture, old siding, pieces of old carpet, wood demolition waste and assorted trash. This waste is shown in photographs 017, 018 and 019.

Apparent violations are marked on the attached checklist.


