

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

1. That Southern Indiana Tire, Inc. is the current owner and operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 400 E. Main Street, Robinson, Crawford County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Robinson/Best one of Robinson.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0330255062.
3. That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
4. That on December 14, 2011, Curt White of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Champaign Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy

of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 1-25-12, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7009 2820 0001 7496 2234.

#### VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Curt White during the course of his December 14, 2011 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in used tires, at this site, not altered, covered or otherwise prevented from accumulating water, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than February 29, 2012, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois

Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS  
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

**INSPECTION REPORT NARRATIVE**

On July 20, 2011 at 11:30 am, I conducted an inspection at Best One of Robinson, located at 400 E. Main Street, Robinson, Illinois 62454, ph# 618/544-3811. The purpose of the inspection was to determine regulatory status and evaluate compliance with the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code, Subtitle G: Land Pollution (Regulations). The inspection consisted of walking around the site, taking pictures, and talking to Keith Kocher, Manage. The weather was cloudy and the temperature 55° F.

Best One of Robinson deals in general automotive repair, maintenance and sell at retail new tires.

**DECEMBER 14, 2011 INSPECTION FINDINGS**

I arrived on site at 11:15 am and walked around the property. I observed another 100 used tires being stored outside (see photos 1, 4 & 5). I estimated half of the tires being stored outside were new and the other half were used tires. I inspected the used tires for water accumulation. I observed water accumulation and organic matter (see photos 2, 3 & 6). I inspected the used tires for mosquito larva. I observed no mosquito larva. I proceeded to the office and informed Mr. Kocher the results of my inspection. We went outside and I showed Mr. Kocher the water accumulation in the used tires. I told Mr. Kocher that all used tires needed to be prevented from accumulating water. I left the site at 11:45 am.

**APPARENT VIOLATIONS CITED DURING THIS INSPECTION WERE:**

1. Pursuant to Section 55(a)(3) of the Act, except at a tire storage site, which contains more than 50, used or waste tires, no person shall cause or allow storage of any used tire unless the used tire is altered, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water.

A violation of Section 55(a)(3) is alleged for the following reason: **Used tires at this site were not altered, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water.**

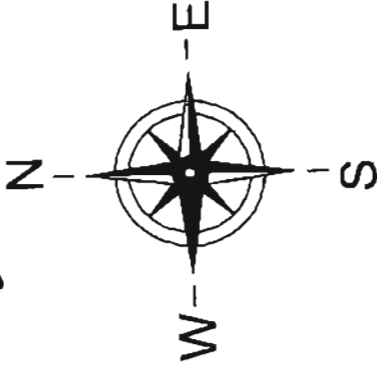
2. Pursuant to Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow storage of any used tire unless the used tire is altered, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water.

A violation of Section 55(k)(1) is alleged for the following reason: **Used tires at this site were not altered, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water.**

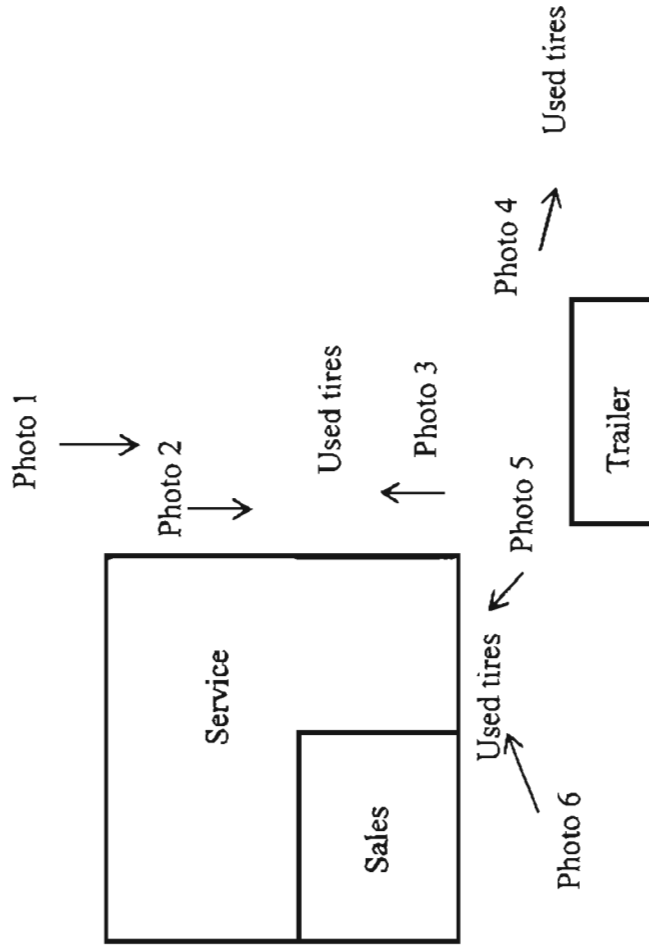
