ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On January 23, 2012, Lakeland Food & Gas, Inc. (Lakeland) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund for Lakeland's leaking UST site located at 1420 Lakeland Boulevard in Mattoon, Coles County. Lakeland had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) rejecting Lakeland's UST Fund reimbursement request. Lakeland's motion represents that the parties have resolved their disagreements and that Lakeland no longer seeks Board review of the Agency's determination. The Board grants Lakeland's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
