ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On February 9, 2012, Geneseo Municipal Utilities (petitioner) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) issued to petitioner by the Illinois Environmental Agency (Agency) on April 6, 2011. The FESOP concerns petitioner's electric generating plant located at 433 East North Street in Geneseo, Henry County.

In the motion for voluntary dismissal, petitioner states that on January 17, 2012, the Agency issued a revised FESOP to petitioner. Petition at 1. According to petitioner, the issuance of the revised FESOP resolves all issues between the parties and "the revised FESOP is only effective upon withdrawal of this appeal." *Id.* Petitioner further represents that counsel for the Agency does not object to the motion. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
