## AFFIDAVIT

I, Michelle M. Ryan, being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and state as follows:

1. I am employed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), as Assistant Counsel for the Bureau of Land.

2. As part of my duties, I am responsible for the preparation of Administrative Citations issued by the Illinois EPA and the negotiation and litigation of appeals filed pursuant to such Administrative Citations. As part of my job experience, I have also submitted travel vouchers for reimbursement.

3. I have reviewed the Illinois EPA Division of Legal Counsel File 124-10-AC, which relates to AC 10-21, *Illinois EPA v. David Charles Bettis*, for the purpose of determining the costs expended by Illinois EPA.

4. I was the Illinois EPA attorney assigned to handle the hearing for AC 10-21, which was held in Carollton. I was required to travel from Springfield to Carollton and back for the hearing. The Illinois Department of Transportation map of the State of Illinois indicates that the distance between Springfield and Carollton is 70 miles. Based on my own job experience, I am aware that the approved mileage reimbursement rate in November 2011 was \$.50 per mile.

5. On November 2, 2011, I traveled to the hearing in this matter as well as another hearing in Carrollton for a hearing on AC 11-13, *Illinois EPA v. Ray Newingham*. As a result, I

made one round trip for a total of two hearings. Therefore, Illinois EPA is claiming half of these actual mileage costs for this matter, totaling \$35.00.

5. As the attorney currently assigned to handle Administrative Citations, I am aware that Illinois EPA incurs costs for copying documents, preparation of documents for mailing and service, and certified and first class mailings. Based upon my review of File 124-10-AC, I estimate that these costs expended by Illinois EPA on this Administrative Citation through the hearing date approximate \$35.00.
