ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C. A. Zalewski):

On July 26, 2011, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) timely filed an administrative citation against Gaylon and Lois Harrell (respondents). *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1(c) (2008); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 108.202(c). The administrative citation concerns a facility located southeast of the Village of Latham, Logan County. The property is commonly known to the Agency as the “Latham/Harrell” site and is designated with Site Code No. 1078105003. On September 2, 2011, respondents filed a petition for review. The Board accepted respondents’ petition for review on September 8, 2011.

On February 27, 2012, the Agency filed a motion for voluntary dismissal of the administrative citation. In the motion, the Agency states that “[b]ased on newly-discovered circumstances surrounding this case, Illinois EPA believes that it is now appropriate to dismiss this Administrative Citation against Respondents.” Motion at 1. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
