JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That John K. Croslow is the current operator ("Respondent") of a facility located approximately 1.75 miles south of Bridgeport at 719 N 800 E Road, Lawrence County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Croslow, Marguerite.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1018025004.
 - 3. That Respondent has operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on February 15, 2012, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>4-3-12</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7009 2820 0001 7496 0711</u>.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his February 15, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2010).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).
- (4) That Respondent caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Six Thousand Dollars</u> (\$6,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>April 30, 2012</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Subject: Open Dump Site Inspection at Marguerite Croslow Property

General Remarks: An Open Dump Site Inspection was conducted on Wednesday, February 15, 2012, at property owned by Marguerite Croslow. Garrison Gross, representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land, conducted the inspection. David Carter representing Illinois the Department of Natural Resources Division of Oil and Gas was present during the inspection. The property is located approximately 1.75 miles south of Bridgeport at ~719 N 800 E Road. The inspection was performed as a follow up to a telephone complaint (C-12-011-M) alleging open dumping and open burning of tires. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were overcast skies, rain, 43° F, with a light breeze. Surface conditions were wet and muddy.

Inspection Findings: The inspection began at approximately 11:45 a.m. We entered the site from 800 E Road (County Road 8) and traveled west approximately 400 yards along a single lane gravel and dirt road. The site consisted of agricultural fields and a wooded area. The road spilt and we continued up the left branch which led in a northwesterly direction. Approximately 140 yards from the intersection, we observed evidence of open burning. An area approximately 20 feet in diameter, was observed that contained numerous tire beads, steel belting, tire residue, ash, shingles and painted dimensional lumber (photos 001-003). A 1-gallon metal can was laying at the east edge of the pile and the contents may have been used as an accelerant. One unburned tire was present and it contained water and organic matter (photo 004). Due to the lack of leaves or surrounding vegetation, it appeared that the open burning of tires at this area was recent.

We traveled back to the intersection and followed the other branch north. We observed another area where open burning had occurred (photo 005 and 006). This area was approximately 12 feet in diameter and contained steel belting, tire residue, ash and unburned pieces of tires. One unburned tire was present and it contained water and organic matter (photo 007). The site was partially covered with hay bales and landscape waste (leaves). Due to the amount of landscape waste that was present, it appeared that the leaves had been dumped at the site; possibly to conceal the burning activities.

We continued north along the access road. Several men were working on an oil well along the northern part of the property. I did not interview them. Approximately 100 truck and tractor tires were observed in the wooded area located between the two access roads (photo 008 - 010). The tires were off the rim and contained water and organic matter. Some of the tires in this area appeared to have been there for a long time. Trees were growing up through some of the tires and algae was growing on some of them (photo 011). Approximately 30 cubic yards of waste was observed at the site. The inspection ended at approximately 12:05 p.m.

Additional Remarks: Information concerning property ownership / control was obtained through tax records from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Lawrence County. Marguerite Croslow, 308 Fairmont Street, Bridgeport, Illinois 62417 is listed as the owner. The tax bill is mailed to Gerald R. Croslow, 28 Edgewood Lane, Centralia, Illinois 62801. The property is referred to as parcel 03-000-305-00 containing 37 acres and parcel 03-000-306-00 containing 40 acres.




