SUPPLEMENTAL PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING GROUNDWATER MONITORING COSTS SUBMITTED BY WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ILLINOIS, INC.

Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. ("Waste Management") by and through its counsel, Dennis Wilt, hereby files a supplemental public comment in this matter regarding groundwater monitoring costs, pursuant to the Hearing Officer Order issued on March 14, 2012.

During the March 13 public hearing, Mr. Liss, who appeared on behalf of Waste Management, was questioned by Mr. Wight with respect to the costs of a basic groundwater monitoring system (see pages 129-130 of the March 13 transcript). Attached as Exhibit A to this Supplemental Public Comment is a chart prepared by Mr. Liss indicating that the total cost of a simple groundwater monitoring system with four thirty-foot wells (three upgradient and one downgradient) would range between \$5,400 and \$12,000. When extrapolated over many tons of soil over many years, the cost per ton is insignificant, being a few pennies per ton.
