ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

On June 1, 2011, Gary Cooper timely filed a petition asking the Board to review an April 27, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.402, 105.404. The Agency's determination concerns Mr. Cooper's leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at a former service station property, commonly known as Royal Station, in Royal, Champaign County.

On May 2, 2012, Mr. Cooper filed a motion to dismiss this appeal. Mr. Cooper states that, during the pendency of this appeal, the parties have been able to resolve their disagreements. Mot. at 1. Accordingly, Mr. Cooper no longer seeks to appeal the Agency's UST decision. *Id.* The Board grants the motion, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
