This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq., specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

- 1. The Respondent, S.I. Waste Systems, LLC, d/b/a Midwest Waste, is the present owner and operator of a waste hauling/trucking company located at 716 Skyline Drive, Marion, Williamson County, Illinois 62959.
- 2. The Respondent was in responsible charge of a tractor-trailer truck with Illinois license number 326 523s/t being driven from the Southern Illinois Regional Landfill near DeSoto, Jackson County, Illinois then onto Landfill Road and then turn South onto U.S. Route 51 near the Village of DeSoto, Illinois, on April 10, 2012.
 - 3. The Respondent has owned said vehicle for all material times hereto.
- 4. On April 10, 2012, Don Terry, Environmental Compliance Inspector, and Kerri Gale, both employed by the Jackson County Health Department witnessed litter being blown out of the vehicle at or around a point North of Dumaroc Road on U.S. Route 51. A copy of Mr. Terry's report and his affidavit is attached hereto and made a part hereto.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of his direct observations on April 10, 2012, he determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping; and resulted in the following violation:

1. The Respondent has caused or allowed litter in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars</u> (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than July15, 2012, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1, and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of

this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) County of Jackson, c/o Jackson County Treasurer, Jackson County Courthouse, Murphsyboro, Illinois 62966; and
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may either initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

GENERAL REMARKS

During the stated date and time, I conducted an inspection of the site listed above. This inspection was made as a follow up to a complaint received by the Jackson County Health Department. Complainant stated that transfer trailer trucks were leaving the Southern Illinois Regional Landfill, Inc. (SIRLI) without insuring that the trailers were completely empty and waste remaining in the trailers blew out onto the highway in and around De Soto, IL. My inspection began with the surveillance of transfer trailers leaving SIRLI. My surveillance encompassed U.S. Route 51 from Landfill Road south to IL Route 149 and along IL Route 149 east from U. S. Route 51 to the Jackson County line.

Weather conditions at the start of the inspection were: Sunny with clear skies, moderate winds and a temperature of approximately 49°F. I was accompanied on this inspection by Kerri Gale of the lackson County Health Department. Ms. Gale drove the vehicle while I conducted the inspection and took photos.

At approximately 9:52 a.m. I observed a transfer trailer approaching the intersection of Landfill Road and U. S. Route 51. The trailer was blue and marked with signage showing it belonged to Midwest Waste. I followed the transfer trailer south along U. S. Route 51 towards De Soto. At a point north of Dumaroc Road, I observed a white plastic object blow out of the trailer onto the road (Photo #1, Site **Sketch**). I then observed a second plastic object blow out of the trailer onto the road along with several small items that appeared to be either paper or plastic. At the intersection of U. S. Route 51 and IL Route 149, I observed the Illinois vehicle license on the trailer. The license read 326 523 5 (Photo #2, Site Sketch). The Jackson County Sheriff's Office confirmed that this vehicle license is registered to Southern Illinois Waste Systems, LLC dba Midwest Waste.

My inspection ended at approximately 9:57 a.m.

The total volume of waste observed was < 1 cubic yard.


