JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That Donald E. Gulley is the current owner ("Respondent") of a facility located at 229 Liebengood Lane, Mt. Vernon, Jefferson County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Mt. Vernon/Gulley-Jolly-Trimm.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0818085006.
 - 3. That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on April 23, 2012, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 6-12-12, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7009 2820 0001 7496 1183

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his April 23, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2010).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Four Thousand Five hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty

specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>July 1, 2012</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

1. Affiant is a field inspector employed by the Land Pollution Control Division of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and has been so employed at all times pertinent hereto.

2. On March 23, 2012, between 9:45 a.m. and 9:55 a.m., Affiant conducted an inspection of the Donald E. Gulley, Sheila O. Jolly, *etal* property in Jefferson County, Illinois, known as Mt. Vernon / Gulley-Jolly-Trimm, by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. Said site has been assigned site code number 0818085006 by the Agency.

- 3. Affiant inspected said Mt. Vernon / Gulley-Jolly-Trimm site by an on-site inspection, which included walking and photographing the site.
- 4. As a result of the material actions referred to in paragraph 3 above, Affiant completed the Inspection Report form attached hereto and made a part hereof, which, to the best of Affiant's knowledge and belief, is an accurate representation of Affiant's observations and factual conclusions with respect to said Mt. Subject: Open Dumping / Open Burning Site Inspection at Gulley-Jolly-Trimm Property

General Remarks: An Open Dumping / Open Burning Site Inspection was conducted on Monday, April 23, 2012, at property owned by Donald E. Gulley & Sheila O. Jolly. The property is operated by Raymond H. Trimm. Garrison Gross, representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land, conducted the inspection. The property is located at ~8375 Cherryville Lane, approximately 2.0 miles northeast Waltonville, Illinois. The inspection was performed as a follow up to a telephone compliant alleging open dumping and open burning at the site. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear skies, 48° F, with a light breeze. Surface conditions were dry.

<u>Inspection Findings</u>: The inspection began at approximately 9:45 a.m. Evidence of open dumping and open burning was visible from the road. I entered the site and continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site. A mobile home was located at the site but it was uninhabited. White goods, bath tub, and toilets were observed in the front yard (photo 001). Waste items including windows and a door were located south of the mobile home (photo 002). It appeared that the mobile home was being remodeled.

Area A: A circular area where open burning had occurred was observed behind the mobile home. The area measured approximately 20 feet in diameter. Wastes observed included but were not limited to: ash, partially burned dimensional lumber, paneling, insulation, metal, and household items (photos 003). Evidence that used / waste tires had been burned at the site was also observed (photo 005). Pieces of steel belting were observed in the ash and debris.

Area B: Another circular area where open burning had occurred was located southwest of the mobile home. This area measured approximately 10 feet in diameter. Wastes observed included but were not limited to: ash, glass, metal cans, domicile wastes and a toilet (photo 004).

Approximately 15 cubic yards of waste and debris were observed at the site. The inspection ended at approximately 9:55 a.m.

Additional Remarks: I proceeded to 8031 N. Cherryville Lane (BOL # 0818085005 - Mt. Vernon / Chastain-Trimm) and conducted an Open Dumping / Open Burning Site Inspection at that address. I spoke to Raymond Trimm. He informed me that he would be moving to the Gully site in a couple of weeks. He said he was purchasing the property via contract for deed from Donald Gulley. He told me that he was remodeling the mobile home and had burned trash and demolition debris at the site. I informed him that the debris and ash from both sites should be cleaned up and hauled to a permitted landfill or transfer station. I told him that receipts would need to be submitted to document compliance. I informed him that the Agency would be sending a letter in the near future.


