

#### VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Phillip Fatka and Garrison Gross during the course of the May 23, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than August 15, 2012, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed

in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS  
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

**General Remarks:** A Used / Waste Tire Storage & Mercury Switch Removal Inspection was conducted on Wednesday, May 23, 2012, at Clifton Salvage, Inc. The Inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross and Phillip Fatka representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. Becky Jayne representing the Illinois EPA Pollution Prevention Program accompanied us during the inspection. The site is located at 14079 East Bakerville Road, Mt. Vernon, Illinois 62864. The inspection was routine in nature. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear skies, 75° F, with a light breeze. Surface conditions at the site were dry.

**Inspection Findings:** The inspection began at approximately 10:40 a.m. The inspectors entered the site and met with Gene Clifton. We introduced ourselves and explained the reason for the inspection. The facility buys wrecked vehicles and sells vehicle parts and tires. Mr. Clifton told us that he crushed the majority of his vehicle inventory approximately 3 years ago. We inquired about automotive fluids, batteries, mercury switches and used / waste tires. Mr. Clifton stated that automotive fluids are drained when a vehicle enters the site. Essential parts are stripped from the vehicle at that time. Mercury switches are not removed from the vehicles as required. Used tires are sold at retail and are stored in school buses that have been converted to storage trailers.

We conducted a walking inspection of the facility. Mr. Clifton accompanied us during the inspection. We observed two school buses located east of the office. The buses are used to store used / waste tires. Mr. Clifton told us that each bus contained approximately 50 used / waste tires. More than 50 used / waste tires were being stored outside of the buses (photo 001). The tires were overgrown in weeds and most of the tires had accumulated water. Mosquito larvae were observed in some of the tires (photos 002 and 003). Approximately 30 used / waste tires were observed west of the office and were being stored outside and some were overgrown in vegetation (photos 004 and 005). Water had accumulated in some of the tires.

We observed the shop / dismantling area. A few waste batteries that were being stored inside the shop. Mr. Clifton explained that waste automotive fluids are collected in 5-gallon buckets as the vehicles are drained of fluids. He showed us the where the waste fluids are transferred into 55-gallon drums and mini-tote containers (photo 006). Mr. Clifton informed us that a recycler picks up the used oil and antifreeze on a regular basis. None of the containers were labeled as required.

We returned to the office. We inquired about waste tire disposal. Mr. Clifton explained that he hadn't sold any tires in a long time. Receipts back to February 2012 were located but none

showed the sale of a used tire. Tommy Love of Tom's Tire Service is the waste tire hauler for the business. Mr. Clifton said it had been at least a year since any waste tires had been hauled from the business. A closing conference was held and we informed Mr. Clifton that used / waste tires should be stored inside or protected to prevent them from accumulating water and mosquito larvae. We informed him that the facility should start removing mercury switches from vehicles that are acquired and used / waste automotive fluid containers should be labeled. He was informed that the facility would be receiving a letter in the near future. The inspection ended at approximately 11:30 a.m.

**Additional Remarks:** Information obtained from the Jefferson County Supervisor of Assessment's Office indicated that tax bills are mailed to Howard G. Clifton, Trustee, P.O. Box 1731, Mt. Vernon, Illinois 62864. The site consists of approximately 100 acres and is referred to as parcel 11-21-100-004. Information available from Illinois Secretary of State indicates that Clifton Salvage, Inc. dissolved its corporation status on December 14, 2007. Clifton Salvage, Inc. continues to report taxes to Illinois Department of Revenue. Howard G. Clifton is listed as the president/secretary/treasurer.
