ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On August 1, 2012, Prairie Power, Inc., f/k/a Soyland Power Cooperative, Inc. (Prairie) filed a motion to voluntarily withdraw this appeal, which concerns an application for a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) Permit for Prairie’s former electrical power generation facility (Facility) located near the town of Pearl, Pike County. Prairie had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency that issued Prairie a CAAPP permit with numerous disputed conditions. Prairie has decided to close the Facility. The Board grants Prairie’s motion for voluntary withdrawal of the appeal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
