POST-HEARING COMMENTS OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY GROUP

NOW COMES the ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY GROUP ("IERG") by and through its attorney, Alec M. Davis, and pursuant to the Hearing Officer's order issued at the August 23, 2012 hearing, hereby submits its post-hearing comments in the above-captioned matter.

As stated previously, many IERG member companies are permitted dischargers of the parameters for which the water quality standards are being amended by the Illinois Pollution Control Board's ("Board") First Notice Proposal, and could be impacted by other provisions being amended. Further, the amendments are generally thought to be beneficial to the regulated community as a whole, and IERG encourages the Board to finalize the proposed amendments to the water quality standards as expeditiously as possible.

IERG submits these comments to address a single issue, raised by the Hearing Officer at the August 23, 2012 hearing. Specifically, the Hearing Officer inquired whether hearing participants objected to the Board including a requirement that Agency approval of mixing zones be "in writing" in addition to the language changes suggested by IERG in its First-Notice Comments. To be clear, IERG understands the inquiry to describe a change to the proposed 35 Ill. Admin. Code 302.208(c) (including the language suggested by IERG) to read as follows: Electronic Filing - Received, Clerk's Office, 09/18/2012 ***** PC# 8 ****

c) The human health standard (HHS) for the chemical constituents listed in subsection (f) shall not be exceeded when the stream flow is at or above the harmonic mean flow pursuant to Section 302.658 nor shall an annual average, based on at least eight samples, collected in a manner representative of the sampling period, exceed the HHS except for those waters in which the Agency has approved a mixing zone in writing or in which mixing is allowed pursuant to Section 302.102as provided in subsection (d).

IERG has reviewed the Comments, dated September 14, 2012, submitted by the

Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and concurs with the Agency's assessment of

the Board's change. While IERG does not believe that the change is necessary, it does

not object if the Board chooses to do so.

IERG appreciates the opportunity to provide these comments. Thank you for

your consideration.
