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- 1 HEARING OFFICER CROWLEY: Good afternoon.
- 2 My name is Kathleen Crowley, and I'm the assigned
- 3 Hearing Officer in this proceeding. This is the second
- 4 of two presently scheduled hearings being conducted by
- 5 the Illinois Pollution Control Board in the matter of
- 6 Gasoline Volatility Standards and Motor Vehicle
- 7 Refinishing Proposed Amendments to 35 Illinois
- 8 Administrative Code Parts 211, 215, 218, and 219; our
- 9 Docket 12-24.
- This hearing is being conducted according to
- 11 the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act,
- 12 and the Board's Procedural Rules at today's hearing.
- 13 The Board will conclude its receipt of testimony on the
- 14 merits and economic effect of the Illinois Environmental
- 15 Protection Agencies, April 2nd, 2012, regulatory
- 16 proposal.
- 17 Looking around the room, I see the same cast
- 18 of characters I saw when we concluded the hearing on --
- 19 first hearing, August 23rd. Everyone here present is
- 20 either affiliated with the Board or the EPA or another
- 21 state agency, so I will just mention, seated to my
- 22 right, as you may remember, is Board Member Carrie
- 23 Zalewski, the Board Member coordinating the grille
- 24 making; to her right is Board Member Jennifer Burke; to

- 1 my left is Board Member Deanna Glosser; and to her left
- 2 is Chairman Thomas Holbrook.
- 3 At this point I'd ask you to all introduce
- 4 yourself again, for the benefit of the court reporter,
- 5 beginning with Mr. Mohr for the IEPA.
- 6 MR. MOHR: Good afternoon, my name is Kent,
- 7 assistant counsel for the Illinois EPA. Thank you for
- 8 having us here today. I have with me today two
- 9 witnesses; Mike Rogers in the technical services section
- 10 of the Division of Mobile Source Programs within the
- 11 Bureau of Air at the Illinois EPA, and Annette Fulgenzi,
- 12 who is the project manager of the Illinois Small
- 13 Business Environmental Assistance Program at the
- 14 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, they
- 15 are here to answer any questions that might be asked of
- 16 them.
- 17 We have pre-filed testimony in this matter,
- 18 entitled, "Testimony of Michael D. Rogers". We filed
- 19 that in anticipation of the first hearing, we have not
- 20 pre-filed any other testimony; we do not have any
- 21 testimony here that we plan to make today, unless the
- 22 Board has any questions. At this point I don't feel
- 23 it's necessary to swear in the witnesses, unless there
- 24 are questions from the Board. That's all we have.

- 1 HEARING OFFICER CROWLEY: And they were
- 2 previously sworn, but at this point, let's not. And we
- 3 have a couple representatives from the Department of
- 4 Commerce and Economic Opportunity also.
- 5 MS. DOGGETT: Brook Doggett with the Small
- 6 Business Environmental Assistance Program.
- 7 HEARING OFFICER CROWLEY: And a young lady
- 8 who's left the room for a second, was also present, Erin
- 9 Conley. We have also present, who you may not have
- 10 noticed, Daniel Robinson, who is the attorney assistant
- 11 to Member Burke.
- 12 There is one question that has arisen since
- 13 the last hearing; otherwise, no public comments have
- 14 been filed, no one has contacted me to indicate they had
- 15 any questions or comments. The question that I have is
- 16 a question that was forwarded to me by Deborah Conley of
- 17 the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Ms. Conley
- 18 said that her management would like to know about three
- 19 particular sections, and those are all incorporation by
- 20 reference sections, they are Sections 215.105, 218.112,
- 21 and 219.112. The agency proposal -- proposes to delete
- 22 or update some but not all of those sections, and the
- 23 management question Ms. Conley asked me to pose is
- 24 whether the quote/unquote sections are the latest

- 1 applicable. I believe that part of what her management
- 2 is asking is why some of the incorporations by reference
- 3 are updated and not all of them.
- 4 MR. MOHR: The incorporations by reference,
- 5 sections in 215, 218 and 219, effect those entire parts,
- 6 so the -- in the agency's proposal, we have proposed to
- 7 delete or update only those incorporations by reference
- 8 that are -- relate to the specific sections that we're
- 9 dealing with in this rulemaking and not any other
- 10 sections.
- 11 HEARING OFFICER CROWLEY: Thank you. And
- 12 we'll note for the record that it's been my experience
- 13 that updating even ASTM standards can, perhaps, have
- 14 unintended effects that you would want comment from the
- 15 entire regulated community about; is that your
- 16 experience as well?
- MR. MOHR: Yes.
- 18 HEARING OFFICER CROWLEY: Thank you. Does
- 19 anyone else have any questions? If not, let's go off
- 20 the record for a minute.
- 21 (Off the record.)
- 22 HEARING OFFICER CROWLEY: We're going to go
- 23 back on the record. As there is no other business for
- 24 us today, I will be setting a deadline for a receipt of

Τ	the last written public comments, that's typically after
2	14 days after receipt of the transcript. We had an
3	off the record discussion and determined that Friday,
4	October 12th, 2012, would be an agreeable date for the
5	agency. This allows a couple of days for transcript
6	preparation, and takes us past the Columbus Day holiday
7	on October 8th; no need to expedite this transcript.
8	After review of the transcript public
9	comments and any other material in the record, the Board
10	will then determine whether to adopt a second notice
11	proposal for submission to the Joint Committee on
12	administrative rules as required by the Administrative
13	Procedure Act. The first have feasible date for Board
14	action following close of the comment period would be
15	November 1st or 15th. If there are no other questions,
16	I think we can conclude this hearing, and thank you all
17	very much, we appreciate your attendance and travel.
18	MR. MOHR: Thanks for having us here today.
