ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On April 24, 2009, Union Electric Company d/b/a Amerenue and Kinmundy Power Plant (Union Electric) timely filed a petition (Pet.) asking the Board to review a March 20, 2009, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.302(e). The Agency's determination concerns Union Electric's combustion turbines at Kinmundy Power Plant, which is an electric generating station located at 2816 Kinoka Road, Potaka, Marion County. On October 11, 2012, Union Electric filed a motion to dismiss this appeal. The motion indicates that a revised permit was issued and Union Electric no longer seeks to appeal this permit decision. The motion is hereby granted and the docket is closed.
