The Board docket number for this immediate left Board Chairman Tom Holbrook, the lead Board Member for this rulemaking, at his left is Board Member Jennifer Burke, at my immediate right is Board Member Carrie Zalewski and at my far left is Anand Rao who represents the Board's Technical Unit.

## The Illinois Pollution Control

Board initiated this rulemaking in an order dated September 20th, 2012. The Board did so in response to Public Act $97-1081$, which became effective on August 24th, 2012. One provision of that public act amends Section $22.2(\mathrm{~L})$ of the Environmental Protection Act by extending the duration of special waste hauling permits from one L.A. COURT REPORTERS, LLC. (312) 419-9292

1 year to three years.

To implement that provision, the Board proposed amendments to Part 809 of its solid waste and special waste hauling regulations for first notice publication without commenting on the substantive merits of those amendments.

Those appeared in the Illinois Register on October 5th, 2012, at 36 Illinois Register Page 14600. Today we are, of course, holding the first hearing in this rulemaking in an order dated September 20th, 2012. The Hearing Officer directed participants wishing to pre-file testimony for this hearing to do so on or before Thursday, October 4th, 2012. However, the Board has received no pre-filed testimony.

I do want to note for the record that the Attorney General's Office is represented here and, Ms. Davidson, if you wouldn't object identifying yourself quickly for the record I'd appreciate it.
