<u>JURISDICTION</u>

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That Isidro Nunez d/b/a Chilo's Tire Service is the current operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 1146 5th Avenue, Moline, Rock Island County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Chilo's Tire Service.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1610455289.
 - 3. That Respondent has operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on November 20, 2012 Gerald McGhee, of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 1-3-13, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7010 2780 0002 1167 5508

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Gerald McGhee during the course of his November 20, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/55(k)(1)(2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>January 30, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each

violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

NARRATIVE

On November 20, 2012, I conducted a Tire Storage Inspection from 11:20 a.m. until 11:40 a.m. at Chilo's Tire Service located at 1146 5th Avenue in Moline, Illinois. The facility is owned by Boys and Girls Clubs of the Mississippi Valley, Inc. It is operated by Isidro Nunez d/b/a Chilo's Tire Service.

[The Inspection was conducted as a follow up to an Administrative Citation Warning Notice sent to the registered agent of the owner and the operator Isidro Nunez on September 6, 2012.

On September 20, 2012, a compliance proposal from Catherine E. Hult of Lane and Waterman, LLP was received on behalf of the owner. The compliance deadline was November 12, 2012. On September 21, 2012, the Agency accepted the proposal.

On October 26, 2012, a compliance proposal from Steven E. Balk of McGehee, Olson, Pepping, Balk & Kincaid, LTD was received on behalf of the operator, Isidro Nunez. The compliance deadline was November 12, 2012. On November 1, 2012 the Agency accepted the proposal.]

The facility generates used tires by acquiring them wholesale and selling them at retail. The Used and/or Waste Tire Activity Notification Form was submitted on October 26, 2012. The required written notice under Section 55.8(a)(3) of the Act was not posted. I interviewed Isidro Nunez.

I asked Mr. Nunez to show me a customer invoice showing that the Illinois Tire User Fee is being charged for the sale of used tires. He could not produce customer invoices of any kind and he explained that he doesn't write up customer invoices. I called the Illinois Dept. of Revenue when I returned to the office and verified that the facility filed an ST-8 Return reporting that 82 used tires were sold in the third quarter of 2012. Mr. Gonzalez produced receipts for disposal of 130 used tires from the site on September 26, 2012 by Bell's Hauling & Recycling (T7599).

I observed approximately 125 used tires for disposal stored outside that are not prevented from accumulating water as seen in photograph 5.

I observed about 1875 used tires for sale stored outside behind the facility. Some used tires are stored under tarps and many other are stored outside and not prevented from accumulating water. (See photographs 1, 2, and 6 through 16. Sampling for larval mosquitos was not conducted.

I observed about 300 used tires and a few new tires stored inside a building at the facility as seen in photographs 17, 18, and 19.

I observed about one thousand less tires during this inspection than I observed during the inspection conducted on August 29, 2012, so I asked Mr. Nunez where all the tires had gone. He explained that he removed approximately 600 used tires from the site. About 300 used tires were relocated to a private garage owned by Rosas Narciso located at 426 4th Avenue in Moline.

About 300 used tires were relocated to a private garage owned by Deanna Chaser located at 602 4th Avenue in Moline. Both locations are unregistered tire storage sites. Both sites were inspected on November 20, 2012 following this inspection.

The facility has returned to compliance with apparent violations of Sections 55.8(b) and 55(c) of the Act.

The following continuing apparent violations found in a previous inspection conducted on August 29, 2012 and cited in an Administrative Citation Warning Notice dated September 6, 2012 were observed:

1. Pursuant to Section 55(a)(3) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(a)(3)), no person shall, except at a tire storage site which contains more than 50 used tires, cause or allow the storage of any used tire unless the tire is altered, reprocessed, converted, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water.

A violation of Section 55(a)(3) is alleged for the following reason: Boys and Girls Clubs of the Mississippi Valley, Inc. as owner and Isidro Nunez d/b/a Chilo's Tire Service as operator allowed the storage of used tires that were not prevented from accumulating water.

2. Pursuant to Section 55.8(a)(3) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.8(b)), a person who accepts used tires for recycling under 55.8(a) shall Post in a Conspicuous Place a Written Notice at Least 8.5 by 11 Inches in Size that Includes the Universal Recycling Symbol and the Following Statements: "DO NOT put used tires in the trash.", and "State law requires us to accept used tires for recycling, in exchange for new tires purchased."

A violation of Section 55.8(a)(3) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.8(a)(3)) is alleged for the following reason: Boys and Girls Clubs of the Mississippi Valley, Inc. as owner and Isidro Nunez d/b/a Chilo's Tire Service had not posted the required notice.

3. Pursuant to Section 55.9 of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.9), retailers shall collect the fee from purchaser by adding the fee to the selling price of the tire. The fee imposed shall be stated as a distinct item separate and apart from the selling price.

A violation of Section 55.9 of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.9) is alleged for the following reason: Boys and Girls Clubs of the Mississippi Valley, Inc. as owner and Isidro Nunez d/b/a Chilo's Tire Service failed to collect the fee from purchaser by adding the fee to the selling price of the tire. The fee imposed shall be stated as a distinct item separate and apart from the selling price.

4. Pursuant to Section 55(k)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(k)(1)), no person shall cause or allow water to accumulate in used or waste tires.

The prohibitions specified in this subsection (k) shall be enforceable by the Agency either by administrative citation under Section 31.1 of this Act or as otherwise provided by this Act.




