HEARING REPORT

On November 28, 2012, a hearing in the above-captioned matter was held in the Rockford City Hall, Council Chambers, 425 East State Street, Rockford, Illinois. Hearing Officer Bradley P. Halloran presided.

Attorney Roy Harsch appeared and participated on behalf of the petitioner, Rock River Water Reclamation District (Rock River). Attorneys Christopher J. Grant and Robert Petti appeared and participated on behalf of the respondent, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency).

Preliminary Matters

On November 2, 2012, the respondent filed a motion to supplement record with a draft memorandum of Agency attorney Bill Buscher attached. The motion moves the Board to supplement the record with a draft memorandum prepared by Agency attorney Bill Buscher. The draft consists of 6 pages, marked 867-872. The petitioner has not filed a written response, nor did it note an objection at the hearing. The motion was not ruled on at the hearing but was taken with the case as it is directed to the Board. (Tr. at 265).

On November 20, 2012, the respondent filed a motion *in limine* to exclude irrelevant written testimony and documents not included in the record. The motion states that on November 15, 2012, the petitioner provided respondent with copies of written testimony for James Huff, Gregory Droessler and Dana Carroll along with attached exhibits. Mot. at 2. On November 26, 2012, the petitioner filed its response. On November 28, 2012, at the hearing, the petitioner presented to the hearing officer a corrected copy of its motion marked as Hearing Officer Exhibit A. (Tr. at 6). Oral argument was entertained. (Tr. at 7-24). Complainant did not have a strong objection to the written testimony since the witnesses' were present at the hearing, read their respective written testimony into the record and were cross-examined. Complainant's main objection to the written testimony and attachments was the reference in the documents to 35

Ill. Adm. Code 620 addressing Groundwater Quality. Complainant stated that the Agency did not rely on Part 620 when issuing its denial letter and, therefore, should not be considered by the Board. Over objection, complainant's motion *in limine* was denied and the hearing officer took judicial and administrative notice of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 620.

Exhibits

The petitioner and respondent offered exhibits into evidence at the hearing. An exhibit list itemizing the offered exhibits and summarizing their status is attached to this order.

Briefing Schedule

A post-hearing briefing schedule was discussed at a December 6, 2012, telephonic status conference. As agreed, the petitioner's opening brief must be filed on or before January 10, 2013. The respondent's post-hearing brief must be filed on or before January 31, 2013. Petitioner's reply must be filed on or before February 8, 2013. Public Comment must be filed on or before January 15, 2013.
