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ROCK RIVER WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT MOTION TO REOPEN THE RECORD FOR LEAVE TO FILE INSTANTER PETITIONER'S REPLY TO RESPONDENT'S POST HEARING RESPONSE BRIEF

Now here comes Rock River Water Reclamation District, ("RRWRD") by and through its Attorneys, DRINKER BIDDLE & REATH LLP, and respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer grant this Motion to Open the Record For Leave To File Instanter Petitioner's Reply to Respondent's Post-hearing Response Brief. In support, RRWRD states as follows:
