JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq., specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

- 1. The Respondent, Elmer Rowe, is the present owner and in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.
- 2. The Respondent, Greg Rowe, has access to and operates a facility located in the County of Jackson, Illinois.
- 3. The facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 077 812 5011. The facility is known to the Agency as the Pomona/Elmer Rowe site.
- 4. The Respondents have owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 5. On January 25, 2013, Don Terry, Field Inspector, Jackson County Health Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Mr. Terry's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector Don Terry's direct observation he has determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on January 25, 2013, an inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

- 1. The Respondents have caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
- 2. The Respondents have caused or allowed scavenging at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(2).
- 3. The Respondents have caused or allowed open burning at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3).
- 4. The Respondents have caused or allowed the deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than April 1, 2013, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1, and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) County of Jackson, c/o Jackson County Treasurer, Jackson County Courthouse, Murphsyboro, Illinois 62966; and
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and Page 3 of 7

including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may either initiate proceedings against either or both Respondents in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

GENERAL REMARKS

During the stated date and time, I conducted an inspection of the site listed above. This inspection was made as a follow up to a complaint received by the Jackson County Health Department (Complaint #2013-018). Complainant stated that Greg Rowe, son of the land owner, was bringing in mobiles homes, removing materials that could be sold and then disposed of the remaining materials by open burning them. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were: Sunny with calm winds and a temperature of approximately 41°F. I was accompanied on this inspection by Henry Mulder of the Jackson County Health Department.

I approached the site from the east on Jerusalem Hill Road. From Jerusalem Hill Road I observed what appeared to be a mobile home frame in a field to the north. I observed that the mobile home frame was surrounded by materials scattered on the ground. The materials I observed scattered on the ground around the mobile home frame appeared to have been subjected to burning given that some of the ground and vegetation near the mobile home frame was black. Also most of the materials lying near the mobile home frame were a white/grey color, similar to ash.

I parked my vehicle and entered the site by walking along a driveway that crossed a creek (Site Sketch). To the south I observed waste piles (Photos #1 & #2, Site Sketch Area A). I observed that the ground around one of the waste piles was charred which would indicate that waste had been open burned at this location (Photo #1, Site Sketch Area A). The waste in the piles in the area labeled "A" on the Site Sketch, included, but was not limited to: ash, scrap metal, broken glass, waste tires, dimensional lumber, plywood, metal beverage cans, steel belts from tires, cardboard, an abandoned recreational vehicle, a plastic bucket, PVC pipe, metal electrical boxes and metal mattress springs.

To the east I observed the waste pile from the burned mobile home I saw from Jerusalem Hill Road when I arrived at the site (Photos #3 - #5 & #10, Site Sketch MH1).

I walked to the waste pile labeled MH1 on the Site Sketch. The waste in this pile consisted of, but was not limited to: ash, a steel frame, a metal bathtub, metal vent, PVC pipe, fiberglass insulation, electrical wire, broken gypsum board, and steel belts wrapped around a metal tire rim (Photos #3 - #5 & #10, Site Sketch MH1). The steel belts wrapped around the metal tire rim indicate that waste tires were disposed of by burning along with the other waste from the mobile home. As I walked around this waste pile, I could feel heat being given off by the waste, indicating that the mobile home had been burned recently. Southeast of the waste pile labeled MH1 on the site sketch, I observed a toilet and refrigerator which had been placed away from the burned mobile home (Photo #9, Site Sketch MH1).

East of the waste pile labeled MH1 on the site sketch, I observed other waste piles (Site Sketch Areas B & C). The waste in these piles consisted of but was not limited to: ash, dimensional lumber (some charred and some unburned), fiberglass insulation, wood paneling, wooden furniture, plastic tarpaulins, carpeting, waste tires, cardboard, plastic sheeting, roofing shingles, wooden pallets and roofing metal (Photos #6 - #8, Site Sketch Areas B & C).

I walked north up a small hill and observed what appeared to be waste remaining from the burning of a mobile home or other structure (Photos #11 - #14, Site Sketch MH2). The waste in this area consisted of, but was not limited to: ash, broken gypsum board, dimensional lumber, scrap metal, concrete blocks, fiberglass insulation, metal beverage cans and expanded polystyrene insulation boards. The vegetation and soil near this waste pile, as well as many of the items in the waste pile, were charred, indicating that the waste in this area had been burned at this location.

Mr. Mulder, a sanitarian at the Jackson County Health Department, explained to me that he knew that Mr. Elmer Rowe, the property owner, lived in the residence just south of where we were located. We walked toward the residence, when a dog began barking. At that time an individual came out of the residence and asked if he could help us. We introduced ourselves and asked the individual if he was Mr. Rowe. The individual confirmed that he was Mr. Rowe. It was then explained to Mr. Rowe that the open dumping and open burning of the demolition waste on his property was not permitted in Illinois. It was also explained to Mr. Rowe that the open dumping and open burning of the demolition waste could result in legal actions being taken, resulting in fines starting at \$1500 per violation. Mr. Rowe told us that his son, Greg Rowe was the one doing the trailer demolition and that it would not happen again. Mr. Rowe said his son told him that he could not make any money demolishing trailers and was discontinuing the practice.

The total volume of waste observed was approximately 60 cubic yards.

My inspection ended at approximately 2:01 p.m.

<u>Item #6(21)(d)(2)</u>: Conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation: In violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board: During the inspection, violations of regulations or standards adopted by the Board regarding the operation of a waste-storage, waste-treatment or waste-disposal site were observed. One such violation was of 811.107(k) that prohibits uncontrolled litter at the site. During the inspection, the open dumping of waste that resulted in litter was observed.

<u>Item #7(21)(e)</u>: Dispose, treat, store, or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into the State at/to sites not meeting requirements of the Act: During the inspection, waste that had been brought to this site from another for disposal was observed. 



