This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. Seq., specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

- 1. The Respondent, Indiana Properties, Inc., is the present owner; and is in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Perry, State of Illinois. The Registered Agent of Indiana Properties, Inc., is Kerry Baba.
- 2. The facility is an open dump and designated with the Site Code #1450055027. The facility is known to the Agency as the Cutler/Indiana Properties, Inc. site.
- 3. The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 4. On April 15, 2013, Rebecca Tracy, Field Inspector, Perry County Solid Waste

 Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms.

 Tracy's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector, Rebecca Tracy's, direct observation, she has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on September 15, 2011, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

- The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS
 5/21(p)(1).
- The Respondent has caused or allowed the deposition of construction and/or demolition debris in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7)
- The Respondent has caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires in violation of 415 5/55(k)(1)

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than August 1, 2013, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violations(s) as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) Perry County Solid Waste, c/o Perry County Treasurer, Perry County Government Building, 3764 State Route 13/127, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274; and,
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, PO Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review shall also be filed with David Searby, Assistant State's Attorney, Perry County Courthouse, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274. Your Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation. Your petition must state the reason(s) you believe the present matter should not be issued. If you fail to file your petition and state the reasons the present matter should not be issued, a default order against you will be entered by the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

On April 15, 2013 an open dump inspection was performed at a site on Ram Road, Cutler, IL. To arrive at the site you turn west onto Ram Road via Kangaroo Road. The lot is the second lot after you turn onto Ram Road from Kangaroo Road. This property appears to have been bought at a tax sale.

The information obtained from the Perry County Assessor's office indicates that the owner of the property is Indiana Properties, Inc., and the address listed as where the tax bill is mailed is PO Box 2052, Northbrook, IL 60065. Information obtained from the Illinois Secretary of State's website indicates that the Registered Agent for Indiana Properties, Inc. is Kerry Baba, 610 Sheridan Road 3C, Highwood, IL 60040. The information further indicated that Kerry Baba is also the President of this corporation. The property is described as Lot 3 in Block 3 of Aladdin Subdivision in Township 6-4, with a property index number of 2-64-0320-130.

I arrived at the site at 1:25 p.m. The weather conditions were approximately 75 degrees.

Photo 001: There is a large amount of open dumped garbage, refuse, construction/demolition debris and used/waste tires.

Photo 002: There are open dumped used/waste tires; and, water was observed standing in the tire with no rim.

Photo 003: There is open dumped construction/demolition debris in the form of a gutted, non-inhabitable mobile home.

Photo 004: Open dumped refuse and debris is observed, along with open dumped used/waste tires. Water was observed in some of the open dumped used/waste tires.

I left the site at 1:27 p.m.


