That Respondent, Charles Long, is, and was at all times relevant to this 18 Administrative Citation, the owner of property located at the area of 14503 19 hungry Hollow Road, Danville, more particularly Latitude 40.1433, Longitude -20 87.6702. 21 2. That said property is vacant land which is not permitted as a sanitary landfill 22 or dump area. 3. That on 4/02/2013 Douglas Toole of the Vermilion County Health Department 23 24 inspected the above-described property. Douglas Toole's Affidavit and a copy of 25 his inspection report are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. 26 VIOLATIONS 27 1. On the basis of direct observations personally made by Douglas Toole, the 28 County of Vermilion has determined that on 4/02/13: 29 A. The Respondent was allowing the open dumping of waste which resulted in 30 litter in violation of Section 21(p)(1). 31 32

B. The Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of any waste which results 1 2 in the deposition of general construction or demolition debris and clean construction and demolition debris in violation of Section 21(p)(7). 3 4 5 CIVIL PENALTY 6 Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4), Respondent herein is 7 subject to a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 for each violation of each provision under 8 subsection p of Section 21, plus any hearing costs incurred by the Board should the 9 Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review 10 process described herein below. 11 PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION 12 13 You have the right to contest this Administrative Citation under Section 31.1(d) of 14 the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d). If you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, you must file a petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control, at 15 the State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, 16 Illinois 60601. Such Petition for Review must be filed with thirty-five (35) days of 17 the date of service of this Administrative Citation, or a default judgment will be 18 issued by the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review 19 should be filed with the Vermilion County State's Attorney's Office, Courthouse, 2nd 20 21 Floor, 7 N Vermilion Street, Danville, Illinois, 61832. 22 If you acknowledge the violation herein, the civil penalty specified above shall be 23 due and payable no later than 2-8-2010. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution 24 Control Board for review of the Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days 25 of the service hereof and have not paid the civil penalty by the due date stated above, or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered 26 27 shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed 28 against you. 29 When payment is made, your check should be made payable to the County of Vermilion, Illinois and mailed to the Vermilion County Health Department, 200 South College 30 31 Street, Danville, Illinois, 61832, together with a completed copy of the remittance

form attached hereto.
