OPEN DUMP INSPECTION NARRATIVE

This unpermitted open dump was reinspected on April 2, 2013, by Douglas Toole and Adrianna Krzywicka of the Vermilion County Health Department. The weather was clear, dry, still and about 45 degrees Fahrenheit. Ten photos were taken of the site.

The site is located in Vermilion County, in a ravine near 14503 Hungry Hollow Road in rural Danville, Illinois.

INSPECTORS FINDINGS

We arrived at the site to perform a reinspection at about 12:45 p.m. on April 2, 2013. We spoke with Dale Spencer, the occupant of the home at 14503 Hungry Hollow Road when we arrived, but no one accompanied us during the reinspection.

In general, it did not appear that much cleanup work had taken place at the top of the hill, or on the slope of the hillside, since my previous inspection on November 20, 2012.

However, I observed a dumpster and a cart full of refuse from the site (photos 1,2).

On the north side of the property, we observed appliances, scrap metal and other refuse on the ground and in the ravine (photos 3,4), and a pile of lights, metal fencing and other refuse near the edge of the hillside on the east side of the property (photo 5).

We observed tires, computer monitors, metal barrels, plastic buckets, boards, remodeling waste, scrap metal, household garbage and other refuse on the hillside and near the edge of the hillside (photos 6-10).

We did not observe evidence of recent waste-burning on the property. We left the property at about 1:05 p.m.

On the Inspection Report Checklist for this reinspection, I estimated that there were 100 cubic yards of waste on the site. No measurements were performed to arrive at that estimation, only my observations at the time. The actual amount of waste on the site may vary significantly from that estimation.

SUMMARY OF APPARENT VIOLATIONS

ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT (415 ILCS 5/1 et seq.)

Section 21 (a) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any waste. The open dumping of waste was observed on the site.

Section 21 (d)(1) of the Act: No person shall ... conduct any waste storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without ... a permit granted by the Agency. No Agency permit to conduct a waste storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation for the site was issued.

Section 21 (d)(2) of the Act: No person shall ... conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste disposal operation ... in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under the Act. Violations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board Regulations were observed at the site where waste storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operations were taking place.

Section 21(e) of the Act: No person shall ... dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste ... except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder. The storage and disposal of waste was occurring at a site which did not meet the requirements of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and the Illinois Pollution Control Board Regulations.

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Section 21 (p)(1) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any waste which results in ... litter. Open dumping of waste resulting in litter was observed at the site.

Section 21 (p)(7) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any waste which results in ... the deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris. Open dumping resulting in the deposition of general and clean construction and demolition debris was observed at the site.

Section 55 (a)(1) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any used or waste tire. Open dumping of waste tires was observed at the site.


