

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. Seq.*, specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

1. The Respondents, Donald and Pam Keene , are the present owners; and are in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Perry, State of Illinois.
2. The facility is an open dump and designated with the Site Code #1450155057. The facility is known to the Agency as the Pinckneyville/Keene, Donald and Pam site.
3. The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
4. On May 21, 2013, Rebecca Tracy, Field Inspector, Perry County Solid Waste Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms. Tracy's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector, Rebecca Tracy's, direct observation, she has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on May 15, 2013, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

1. The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
2. The Respondent has caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires in violation of 415 5/55(k)(1)

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than August 15, 2013, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violations(s) as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

(1) Perry County Solid Waste, c/o Perry County Treasurer, Perry County Government Building, 3764 State Route 13/127, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274; and,

(2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, PO Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION



If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review shall also be filed with David Searby, Assistant State's Attorney, Perry County Courthouse, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274. **Your Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation. Your petition must state the reason(s) you believe the present matter should not be issued. If you fail to file your petition and state the reasons the present matter should not be issued, a default order against you will be entered by the Illinois Pollution Control Board.**



On May 21, 2013, an open dump inspection was performed at 103 East Laurel Street, Pinckneyville, IL 62274. The GIS coordinates indicated 38°00.965N and 089°14.319W. The weather was approximately 80 degrees, cloudy and rainy.

The information obtained from the Perry County Assessor's office indicates that the owners of the property are Donald and Pam Keene, whose residence address is 103 East Laurel Street, Pinckneyville, IL 62274. The property is described as 99 x 99, Lot 12 in the Original of Pinckneyville and Property Index No. 2-53-0660-150

I arrived at the site at 11:30 a.m. As depicted in Photos 001 through 011, the property is covered with open dumped and scattered litter, refuse, scrap, used/waste tires and other materials. Further, water is collecting in open dumped used/waste tires as seen in the photos. The property is a nuisance and has an irrefutable unsightly appearance.

I left the site at 11:38 a.m.

The Keene property is being used to collect litter, refuse, scrap and used/waste tires. Although the Keene's should be allowed to collect scrap or other materials for salvage, recycling or selling, they are subject to the Illinois Pollution Control Board's regulations regarding salvaging of materials. Section 810.103, under definitions of "salvaging" indicates that materials must be separated by type and store them in a manner that does not create a nuisance, harbor vectors or cause an unsightly appearance.

Further, the open dumping of materials "in the anticipation of some future use at some undefined time" is not acceptable. (INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD, June 6, 2002, IEPA v. Yocum, AC 01-29 and IEPA v. Yocum, AC 01-30).

During the inspection, the open dumping of waste that resulted in litter in the form of refuse, debris, scrap and used/waste tires was observed. Further, water was accumulating in open dumped used/waste tires

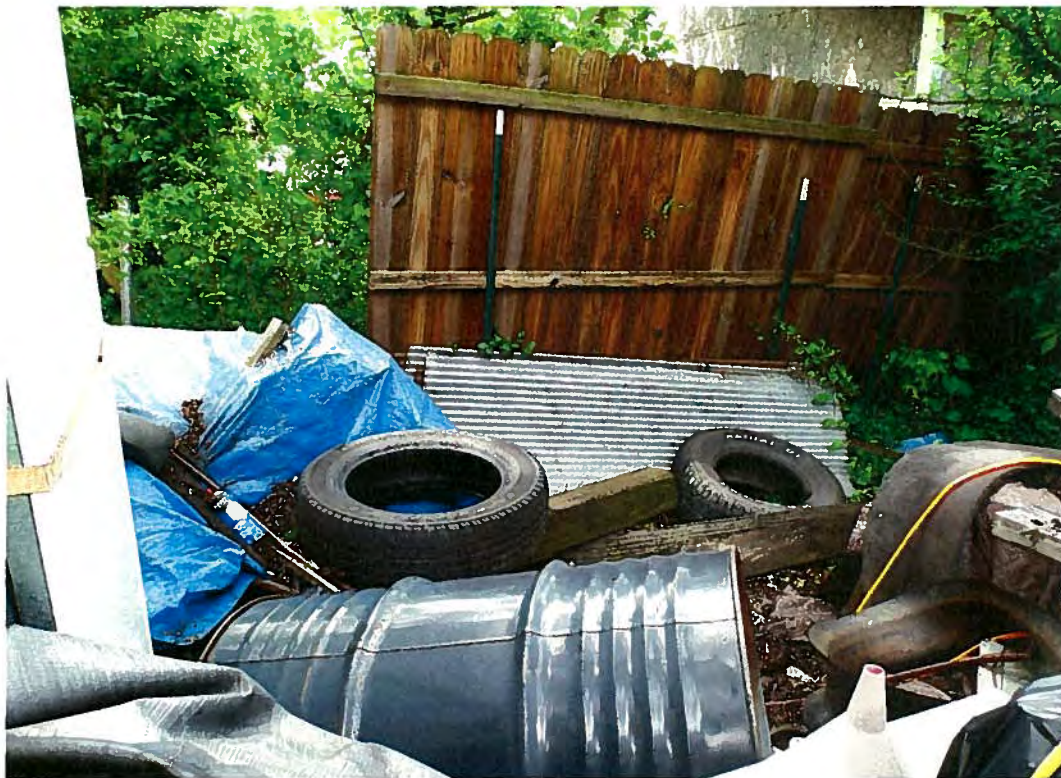

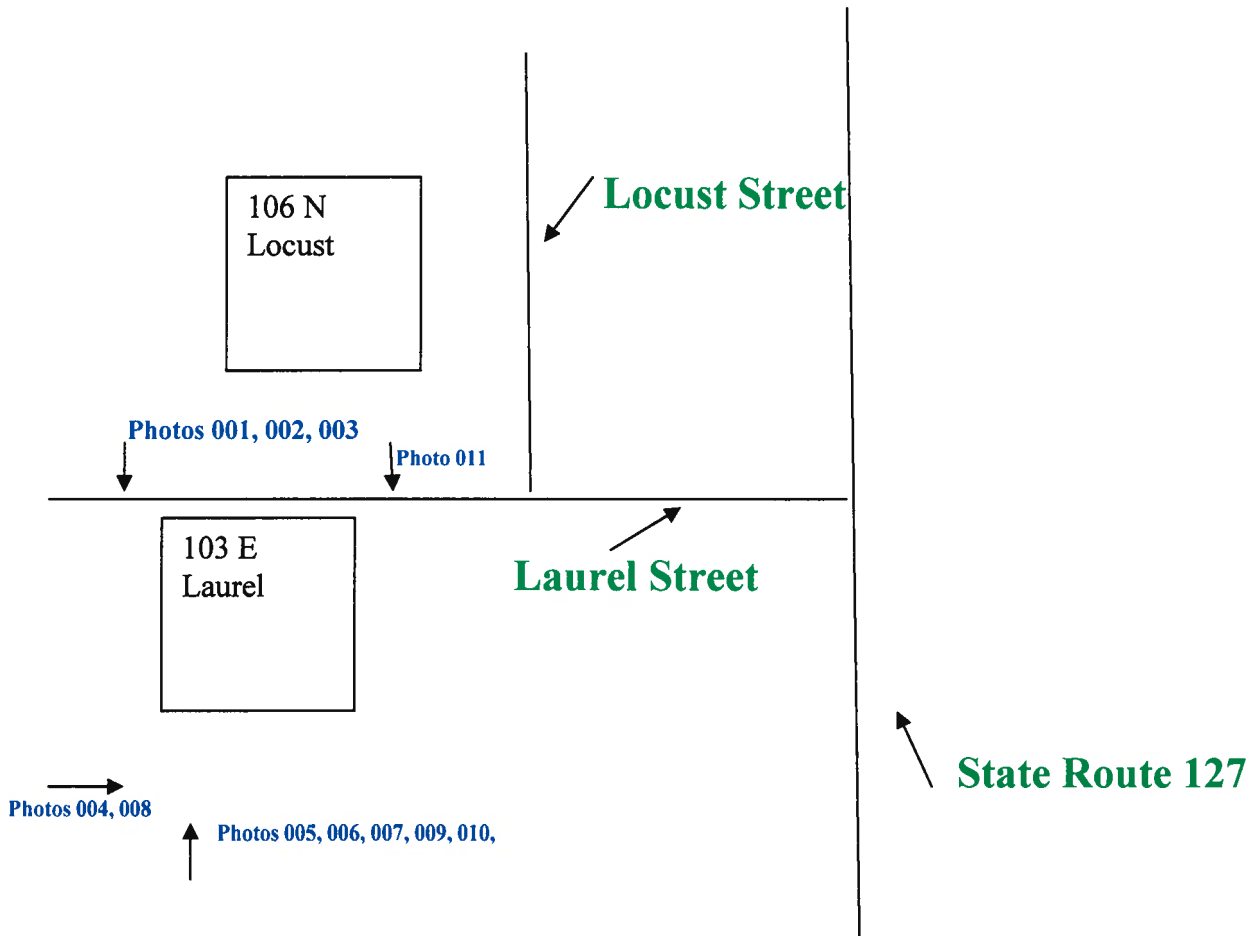
