ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On October 5, 2011, United States Steel Corporation (U.S. Steel) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review an August 31, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206. The determination concerns the issuance of a construction permit for an emission control system for U.S. Steel's basic oxygen process furnaces at the company's integrated steel mill plant in Granite City, Madison County (Facility I.D. No. 119813AAI).

On August 9, 2013, U.S. Steel filed a motion to voluntary dismiss this proceeding. U.S. Steel states that the issues in this appeal were resolved and a revised permit was issued. Because U.S. Steel and the Agency have resolved the issues, U.S. Steel asks that the Board dismiss this proceeding. U.S. Steel indicates that the Agency does not oppose the motion.

The Board grants U.S. Steel's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
