ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

On November 3, 2005, the City of Springfield (City) filed a petition for review asking the Board to review a September 29, 2005 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) to issue a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit with conditions.

On November 13, 2013, the City filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal (Mot.), stating that “all issues raised in this appeal have been resolved” and the Agency has issued a “‘significant modification’ CAAPP permit.” Mot. at 1. The Agency does not object to the motion. *Id.* The Board grants the City’s motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
