RESPONDENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE TO COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO STRIKE

Code 101.522, for a sixty (60) day extension of time to respond to Complainant's Motion to Strike Respondent's Affirmative Defenses. Complainant does not oppose this Motion.
